



The camp in Pušćine was wonderful for me. In my group, one girl accepted Jesus as her Savior. We prayed together. Later I also gave her a Story Time lesson and the New Testament. I pray for her that she may read God's Word and pray every day. She started to attend the church in Pušćine with her parents. She goes to Sunday School every Sunday.

We started the new school year with a course that Vesna, Karmen and I held at the Baptist Church Dubrava, Zagreb. There were only four participants. Kristina was one of them. When I started working at CEF in 2000 Kristina was helping me a lot. At that time, there were 5000 children involved with the correspondence course and every day I was taking 50 letters to the post office. I needed help and Kristina was coming whenever she could, as she was a student at the time. When she applied for the course, I was very happy and encouraged that the Lord called her to work with children at her church. We really enjoyed teaching them in the three days of the course, and we also gained a lot through women who are now involved in spreading the Gospel in their churches and neighborhoods.

I spent three days in October in Hungary. Daniel Fer taught us how to create a web page for an online correspondence course. Every day we had spiritual time led by Zbyšek Šikula from Slovakia. I would love to have the possibility to write to people in Croatia via internet. Children use it for games, and how wonderful would it be if they would also use it to read God's Word.

Ten new children are enrolled in the Story Time correspondence course. These are some new children who attended the camps or Good News Clubs. These children know who they are writing to, they can share their thoughts, their problems or joys with me. I am blessed that the Lord can use me in this ministry.
